

NLTA SAFETY BRIEFING

The following safety rules must be explained before each training session:

1.	Know the following areas; Safe Zone =training area; Unsafe Zone=outside training area; Semi-safe Zone= Equipment and Staging Area (which is inside safe zone)
2.	NO LIVE WEAPONS/AMMUNITION/CHEMICAL IRRITANTS, EDGED OR IMPACT WEAPONS ARE PERMITTED IN THE TRAINING AREA/Safe Zone.
3.	Treat the NLTA weapon with the same degree of seriousness and responsibility afforded a "live" weapon and ammunition. (Laser Rule)
4.	Do not load until directed to do so. (Instructors or their designee will load all NLTA Magazines)
5.	Indiscriminate firing, unsafe or frivolous behavior will not be tolerated.
6.	All participants must wear designated safety equipment and the equipment must remain in place until an instructor ends the exercise, e.g., "OUT OF ROLE," "CEASE FIRE" or a LOUD WHISTLE BLAST
7.	Upon hearing "OUT OF ROLE," "CEASE FIRE" or a LOUD WHISTLE BLAST, stop all activity immediately.
8.	If a helmet or throat guard becomes dislodged during an exercise, immediately protect yourself by shielding the eyes, face or throat area, then begin shouting "CEASE FIRE" or "OUT OF ROLE."
9.	No one will go for your gun; there are no tricks. (Exception: When written scenario identifies weapon retention as an objective.)
10.	Do not physically fight with, punch, kick, strike or otherwise abuse the role players. (Exception: When physical interaction is within the identified parameters of the written scenario, which will be set forth by the instructors prior to exercise.)
11.	If deadly force becomes necessary in a scenario, follow agency policy, ROE's and training.
12.	For safety purposes, do not shoot closer than 1 meter (no contact shots).
13.	Do not give up or quit until stopped by an instructor (Injury or unsafe situations are exception). Everyone is a safety officer and can stop the action at any time if they perceive an unsafe situation by shouting "CEASE FIRE" or "OUT OF ROLE."
14.	Report all injuries to the instructor immediately.
